He played baseball in cities from Tokyo to Los Angeles before deciding to put down roots in the GTA. Having recently retired from pro ball, Chris says he was at a crossroads in his life when The Bachelor Canada opportunity came about.

When it comes to baseball puns, the former pro has certainly heard his share of them on *The Bachelor Canada*, from playing the field to stepping up to the plate. He is quite a "catch" after all.
